Frequently Asked Questions



What are your rates and fees?

Our basic rate is \$550.00 and our packages are customized based on a variety of factors, including event trailer, mileage, and accessories. Once you have submitted your Contact Form, we will get back to you promptly with a quote.

Deposits & Payments

We require a 50% non-refundable payment and a signed contract to book a date as secure. Remaining balances are due 60 days prior to the event date. Cancellations made within the 60 days prior to the event date lose the right to a full refund. When securing a date, we turn away other potential clients for that date, therefore, refunds are not given under any circumstances within 60 days of the booked event date. We accept cash or payments via credit or debit cards, and Venmo.

Do you provide a bartender?

Groggy Frog event trailers are “DRY HIRES”, which means we rent each of our custom mobile bars to be serviced by you, your friends, or your family. We do collaborate with SIP & SASSY TIPS Certified bartenders that can be available for an additional fee.

What can we serve at our event?

ANYTHING YOU WANT! It's your party!

Do you have insurance?

YES! We carry general liability insurance. Your venue may have questions and we will be happy to oblige. We are a Limited Liability Company.

Do you provide alcohol?

No. We do not have a liquor license. You will purchase your alcohol from a separate vendor. (store, caterer, or venue) We will, however, help you determine the amounts you will need to make sure your guests are happy!

What events do you serve?

We love all types of events and celebrations! Weddings, corporate, bridal showers, bach/bachelorette, family or class reunions, block parties, shindigs, picnics, birthdays, car shows, alumni events - you name it, we will be there!

What is your rain plan?

Let's be honest, Michigan weather is very unpredictable! We cannot predict rain or inclement weather. In the event that weather is projected for your event, we will work with you to find a solution that works for everyone!

What do your trailers require?

We require level ground for service, early access for set-up, and the ability to remove the trailer at pick-up.

Where can the trailer be positioned?

Unhitched and in place, our largest trailer is 12 feet long, 8 feet wide, and 12 feet tall. We recommend a wide and easily traveled path/road with enough space to pull the trailer in and out with a full-sized truck.

Can we decorate the trailer?

Yes! You are welcome to add decorations to the trailer to match the look and feel of your event. Any decorations by the client must be hung without using nails, glue, or anything that may damage the trailer in any way.

Where are you located?

We are based out of Clare, Michigan. Our packages include 25 miles round trip from zip code 48617 with a nominal charge for additional mileage. Don't forget, we are on wheels and love a good road trip! Please reach out to discuss outside areas.

Can our venue use your trailer?

YEP! If your venue or catering company provides bar and beverage service, their staff can certainly work from our trailers.

Can we serve beer out of kegs?

YES! ANTHONY HOP-KINS has a kegerator that can fit two half barrels & LOLLI-HOPS has a Jockey Box that can hold two slim quarter kegs. All beer can be kept icy cold for the duration of your event. Kegs should arrive at the venue 3 hours prior to serving to ensure time to settle.
